OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Ballett-Braigbarren





DESCRIPTION	The ballet bracing bar consists of a cast steel base with an inserted tubular steel stand and an attached cast aluminium head to hold the ash sticks. Castors are mounted on both sides of the stand base to facilitate transport of the braigbarre.
USE: (INTENDED PURPOSE)	The ballet braigbarre is a training device for training balance and flexibility in ballet.
IMPROPER USE	The Braigbarre may not be used for gymnastics or climbing. Operation outside of sports halls, on sloping floors or over sharp edges or ledges is not permitted. Improper use will invalidate the manufacturer's guarantee and warranty!
MONTAGE	The Braigbarre is delivered disassembled and assembled. Only the uprights need to be inserted and clamped.
OPERATION	By pulling on the side rails, the Braigbarre can be tilted and moved. Once it has been put down, it stands securely again and is ready for use. If it is necessary to transport the Braigbarre lengthways, the stand feet can be placed on transport plates, making them easy to move even in the tightest of spaces.
HAZARD WARNING	The Braigbarre may not be used for gymnastics or climbing.
